

Over the years, the Supreme Court has consistently ruled in favour of the citizen's right to know. The nature of this
right and the relevant restrictions thereto, has been discussed by the Supreme Court in a number of cases. So it can
be concluded: • Right to Information is a fundamental right but it is not absolute and • Right to Information has
been judicially recognized by the Supreme Court as part of following two Articles of Indian Constitution: Article 19(1)
a)-Freedom of Speech and Expression and Article 21 - Right to Life and Liberty

Refer attachment A details of Universities under your administrative control. These Universities are involved in giving degrees to general public and they need to (their website of these Universities) confirm to the requirements of section 4 of RTI Act 2005 as explained below.

Section 4(1)(a) requires public Authorities to provide public Access to computerized records. As such all information on these Universities Web-site should be available to all citizens. Section 4(1)(b) requires these Universities to disclose 14 items listed there in. These Universities need to comply with section 4(1)(c) and 4(1)(d).

According to section 4(2), these Universities need to suo-moto disclose and disseminate information needed by the public so that citizens do not have to resort to RTI Act to get the information needed by them. As per section 4(3) and 4(4) requires
