

Over the years, the Supreme Court has consistently ruled in favour of the citizen's right to know. The nature of this right and the relevant restrictions thereto, has been discussed by the Supreme Court in a number of cases. So it can be concluded: • Right to Information is a fundamental right but it is not absolute and • Right to Information has been judicially recognized by the Supreme Court as part of following two Articles of Indian Constitution: Article 19(1) (a)-Freedom of Speech and Expression and Article 21 - Right to Life and Liberty

For proper enjoyment of Freedom of Speech and Expression as well as Right to Life and Liberty, it is imperative that correct information is available to the Citizens.
