This is in reference to this Directorate's letter no. DHE.6(32)/Court Case/2012-13/2226-2233 dated 13.06.2025 (copy enclosed) regarding providing reservation to the wards of Defence/Paramilitary force/Police Personnel. In this regard, I am directed to clarify that:

1. This Directorate issued letter dated 11.04.2013 along with letter no. 3547/AS(R)94 dated 03.06.1994 with the direction that all the Universities and Colleges of GNCTD shall follow the policy prescribed by Govt. of India. (copy enclosed)
2. Further, this Directorate issued letter dated 06.07.2018 vide which a copy of letter dated 21.05.2018 of Joint Secretary, RES-II, Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare, MOD, Govt. of India was circulated for implementation. (copy enclosed)
3. Furthermore, as per the directions of Hon'ble Dy. CM, GNCTD, it was conveyed to follow the same reservation policy as per previous year of 2018-19 in the forthcoming sessions in admission to the wards of paramilitary forces/police personnel vide letter of even no. dated 08.05.2019. (copy enclosed)

In this regard, I am directed to clarify that the Universities/Institutions under DHE/DTTE shall adhere and follow the prevalent policy of DHE for providing reservation to Wards of Armed forces and Paramilitary force/Police personnel circulated vide letter dated 11.04.2013 and 08.05.2019. The reservation to the wards of the Paramilitary force was provided, priority wise, as per DHE Order dated 11.04.2013, which may be continued in true letter and spirit of letter dated 08.05.2019. Further, the wards of recipients of the President's Police Medal for Gallantry and Police Medal for Gallantry shall also be included for providing reservation to Paramilitary force/Police personnel in Priority V.

State Governments have provided for some reservation or preference for admission to medical/professional colleges for the wards of Defence personnels. It has been noticed that the order of preference differs from state to state and in many states, the preference list does not include the wards of Gallantry Award winners, ex-Servicemen and serving personnel of Armed Forces, thereby the seats reserved for Defence category are not utilized and are transferred to general pool.

2. Though education is a State subject and Universities are autonomous bodies, standardization of preference for admission in defence quota is described to bring about uniformly in the States/UTs. For the purpose of standardization, the following prioritization is recommended:-

PRIORITY I- Widows/wards of Defence Personnel/Para Military Personnel killed in action.

PRIORITY II-Wards of serving personnel and ex-servicemen/Para Military Personnel disabled in action.

PRIORITY III-Widows/wards of defence Personnel/ Para Military Personnel who died in peace time with death attributable to Military Service.

PRIORITY IV-Wards of Defence Personnel/ Para Military Personnel disabled in peace time with disability attributable to Military Service.

PRIORITY V- Wards of ex-servicemen personnel and serving personnel/ para military/police personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards:-

1. Param Vir Chakra
2. Ashok Chakra







Due to which wards of Para Military/Police personnel are not benefited the concession granted by Delhi University in admission.

2. In view of above, it is requested that not to alter the criteria of reservation in respect of wards of Para Military/Police personnel who are in receipt of President's Police Medal for Gallantry and Police Medal for Gallantry and maintain it as per previous year i.e 2017-18.
