Memorandum of Understanding between Department of Training 2001
Technical Education, Covernment of National Capital Technical Education, Singapore, on Cooperation in the Field of Mocational Education (VE) and Skills Development (SD) for Setting up of

Green Field World-Class Skills Development Centre at Delhi

The Department of Training and Technical Education, Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi, India, (hereinafter referred as "DTTE") and Institute of Technical Education, Singapore (hereinafter referred as "ITE") (hereinafter jointly referred to as "the Parties");

Recognising the long-standing and friendly ties between the two countries and wishing to expand cooperation in the field of Vocational Education (VE) and Skills Development (SD);

Recognising their common commitments for promoting and expanding bilateral relations in the field of VE and SD:

Recognising Singapore's commitment towards complementing the reform process in the field of SD taking place in Delhi;

Hereby emphasise their willingness to further the cooperation and reach the following understanding:

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred as "MOU") sets out the nature and scope of cooperation between DTTE and ITE, in the field of VE and SD, without creating binding or legal obligations on either Party.

It serves as a general framework under which specific projects to be implemented through DTTE and ITE's subsidiary, ITE Education Services Pte Ltd (ITEES), may be proposed, formulated and agreed upon by both Parties for implementation. For these projects, DTTE and ITEES shall sign separate Agreements and Terms, detailing the scope of work, project schedule, project costings, payment schedule, and roles and responsibilities of DTTE and ITEES.



This MOU shall apply to cooperation between the two Parties concerning the following areas of VE and SD, within their national objectives and the relevant laws as may be applicable:

- Setting up of a Green Field World-Class Skills Development Centre at Delhi.
- II. Upgrading and enhancement of existing vocational training institutions.
- III. Training of Trainers.
- IV. Development of competency standards.
- V. Development of curriculum and instructional materials.
- VI. Any other areas mutually agreed upon between the Parties.

The Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi proposes to set up the Green Field World-Class Skills Development Centre (hereinafter referred as "Centre"), at Delhi;

- To provide state-of-the-art facility for skills development at Delhi and create skilled manpower as per industrial requirement of the region having a capacity for skills development for 10,000 - 15,000 students/trainees with such residential facilities as may be required.
- The land for the Centre will be provided by DTTE.
- The Centre will be developed over three distinct stages to be implemented sequentially over five years. The implementation details for each stage, including the roles and responsibilities of DTTE and ITEES, will be discussed, finalised and signed upon in separate Agreements and Terms between DTTE and ITEES.
- An autonomous body is being proposed to run the Centre.
- The Parties shall cooperate to create facilities for the following disciplines/courses

- 1. Health
- 3. IT and IT-Enabled Services
- 5. Retail Merchandising
- 7. Production and Manufacturing
- 9. Food Processing
- 11. Any other trades that may be agreed.
- 2. Hospitality and Tourism
- 4. Accounting, Banking and Finance
- 6. Automobile
- 8. Logistics
- 10. Electronics

The Parties shall lay emphasis on the design and features of the proposed Green Field World-Class Skills Development Centre. The scope of consultation will focus on the design and construction of the Centre.

The Parties shall work together in the development of curricula and training materials and procurement and installation of training equipment in the chosen trades based on mutually-agreed terms.

Each Party undertakes to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from, or supplied to the other Party during the period of the implementation of the MOU or any other agreements made pursuant to this MOU.

The Parties shall conduct comprehensive 'Train-the-Trainer' programmes, including the first batch of faculty across chosen trades in Singapore. Refresher courses will be done on an on-going basis based on mutually-agreed needs and terms. The programmes could be offered at the Skills Development Centre in Jonapur, Delhi, in future, to train vocational teachers from all across the region.

The Parties shall constitute a Joint Working Group (JWG) on VE and SD, which will be the platform for dialogue and exchange of information to facilitate cooperation, foster partnerships and review progress. The JWG will meet alternately in Singapore and India at least once every year. Both Parties shall determine the composition of the JWG for their side. The expenses for organising the JWG shall be borne by the Party hosting the meetings. The Party which is sending representatives for

participation in the meetings of the JWG shall bear its own travel and living expenses. However, local hospitality will be provided by the host.

The cost of activities in setting up the Centre and other areas of cooperation shall be funded as mutually agreed by DTTE and ITEES in separate Agreements and Terms.

Each Party will protect, within its territory, intellectual property rights of the other Party in accordance with domestic laws in force in their respective countries.

The Parties will ensure appropriate and efficient protection of intellectual property rights obtained on the basis of this MOU, in accordance with laws and regulations in force in their respective countries and in accordance with the international agreements to which they are Parties.

This MOU shall come into effect on the date of its signature and shall remain in force for a period of five (5) years. Thereafter it may be reviewed for further periods by mutual agreement of the Parties. This MOU may be amended by mutual understanding of the Parties. Either Party may terminate this MOU by notifying the other Party in writing at least ninety (90) days in advance of such termination. Any dispute regarding the interpretation or application of this Memorandum will be resolved amicably by consultation between the Parties.

Signed at New Delhi on 11th July 2012 in two originals each in Hindi and English, both texts being equally authentic. In case of divergence in interpretation, the English text shall prevail.

Under **Section 11** (third party) of the Act, all the private industries, banks or any other firms, which has some kind of business dealings/contractual relationships with the public authorities, are covered. Citizens can ask for information about these firms from the public authorities, which maintain their records.

1. Third Party has no absolute right to refuse information disclosure about it [Sec. 11(1) of the RTI Act]

<u>Case</u>: In the case of *K.K. Mahajan vs. Cantonment Executive Office* (CIC/AT/A/2006/00014, dated 22/5/2006), the appellant, an employee of a public

authority, had applied for some information relating to the prosecution of another employee (third party), because under similar circumstances the appellant was convicted while the other employee was exonerated.

The public authority refused to provide him the information he had asked for on the ground that the third party had refused the disclosure of information about it to the applicant.

<u>Judgment:</u> The CIC held that the RTI Act does not give a third party an automatic right to order the public information officer (PIO) of a public authority, not to disclose information pertaining to it.

The CIC further held that the public authority is required to evaluate the third party's case in terms of the provisions of **Section 8(1)(j)** and **Section 11(1)** of the RTI Act, 2005, and find out that the information asked is not barred from disclosure.

Even if the information is barred from disclosure then the public authority is to examine if it would be in the public interest to disclose the information sought and its disclosure will outweigh harm if any to the individual third party.

The public authority has to arrive at the findings by properly assessing the facts and circumstances of the case. A speaking order should thereafter be passed accordingly

Section 8(1) - Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, there shall be no obligation to give any citizen,—

(j) information which relates to personal information, the disclosure of which has no relationship to any public activity or interest, or which would cause unwarranted invasion of the privacy of the individual unless the Central Public Information Officer or the State Public Information Officer or the appellate authority, as the case may be, is satisfied that the larger public interest justifies the disclosure of such information:

Provided that the information which cannot be denied to the Parliament or a State Legislature shall not be denied to any person.
