With reference to above mentioned RTI, reply pertaining to this Branch is as under:


The U.G.C. has launched a scheme on skills development based higher education leading to Bachelor of Vocation (B. Voc.) degree with multiple exits such as Diploma / Advanced Diploma and degree. This would enable the pass-outs of B. Voc. Program at various levels to contribute in accelerating India's economy by gaining appropriate employment or becoming successful entrepreneurs.

To keep pace with the changing educational scenario in the country, it was proposed that Govt. polytechnics in Delhi may be developed as integrated models of educational institutions where diploma level as well as B. Voc. degree level education could be imparted to the students who opt for vocational streams.

In view of the above, proposal regarding change of nomenclature of Govt. Polytechnic to Institute of Technology was discussed in a meeting with Director (TTE) and Principal of Polytechnics. The proposal was further amended as per the directions. Accordingly a proposal was initiated and submitted to worthy Lt. Governor for approval. After the approval, order No. F.161/12/Nomenclature-B.Voc / DD(TE)/2015/2188 Dated 11/05/2015 was issued regarding re-designation of the diploma level institutes functioning under the aegis of Department of Training and Technical Education Govt. of NCT of Delhi. (Copy of the same is enclosed herewith).

It is further informed that Nine Govt. Institute offering diploma level education have suggested the disciplines in which they can run B. Voc courses depending upon their diploma level expertise available in the institute in proposed B. Voc branches. (The copy of detailed discussion during the meeting with new proposed institute names and suggested course is enclosed.)
