
Sir,

With reference to your application received on **14/ 06/2019** vide ID No. **4810** addressed to the undersigned regarding supply of information under Right to Information Act 2005 received under RTI Act 2005. The replies/information in r/o DTTE (HQ) provided by Custodians of record whose help was taken u/s 5(4) of RTI Act 2005 is as under:

Information Sought	Information provided as per available records in the office
Information as per Sl. No. 1 to 3	<p>The information sought by the applicant under RTI application is related to the date from which he will be allowed to join this department on selection to the post of Grade-IV(DASS)/JA. In this regard, attention is invited to the decision of Central Information Commissikon in Appeal No. CIC/SB/A/2016/001025/CBECE-BJ titled as (Subrata Guha Ray v/s CPIO Jt. Commissioner, Directorate General of Vigilance, Custom and Central Excise, New Delhi). In the said decision CIC has given references to the various judgments of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and Hon'ble High Court of Bombay and Madras reciting therein that "where the information sought is not a part of the record of a Public Authority, and where such information is not required to the maintained under any law or the rules or regulations of the public authority, the Act does not cast an obligation upon the public authority, to collect or collate such non-available information and then furnish it to an applicant. A Public Authority also not required to furnish information which require drawing of inferences and/or making of assumptions.....".</p> <p>The information sought by the applicant is on making an assumption regarding the date he will be allowed to join this department to the post of Grade IV (DASS)/JA the desired information on which is not covered under the RTI Act in the light of CIC decision referred above. It is further added that the Character and Antecedents report in r/o the Applicant Sh. Rakesh Dagar received from the Police Authorities and a case has been informed as pending trial against the applicant in FIR No. 60/18 under Sector 323/341/506/34 IPC. The candidature of the applicant is under consideration and the decision/outcome of the same will be informed to him accordingly.</p>
