Padmanabhan Committee in respect of Judicial Officers, as conveyed by Government of India, Ministry of Law & Justice, Department of Justice, vide their letter No.L-19018/5/2009-Jus., dated 21.09.2011, subject to following conditions:-

- (i) That those judicial officers who avail fixed medical allowance shall not be eligible for medical reimbursement Under Delhi Government Employees Health Scheme; and
- (ii) That those judicial officers who avail conveyance allowance will not be eligible for provision of official/government vehicle.

Sir,

In continuation of this Department's sanction letter of even number dated 1st September, 2011 on the subject mentioned above, I am directed to say that the Central Government have given careful consideration to the recommendations of Justice E. Padmanabhan Committee in respect of allowances etc. of judicial officers and pensionary benefits to pre-2006 and post-2006 retired judicial officers in order to give effect to the same, in so far as they relate to the judicial officers of the Union Territories. Sanction of the competent authority is hereby conveyed as follows:-

(i) SUMPTUARY ALLOWANCE:

	<u>Existing</u>	<u>Revised</u>
(a) Civil Judge (Jr.Divn.)	Rs.500/-p.m.	Rs.1500/-p.m.
(b) Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.)	Rs.750/-p.m.	Rs.2300/-p.m.
(c) District Judges (all levels)	Rs.1000/-p.m.	Rs.3100/-p.m. ✓

(ii) MEDICAL ALLOWANCE: Rs.1000/- per month for all judicial officers in place of Rs.100/- per month. ✓

(iii) ROBE ALLOWANCE: Robe Allowance @ Rs.6,000/- be paid to every judicial officer once in three years.

DA, CCA, CONVEYANCE ALLOWANCE, HILL ALLOWANCE, TRANSFER GRANT/DISTURBANCE ALLOWANCE, CONCURRENT CHARGE ALLOWANCE, NEWSPAPER AND MAGAZINE ALLOWANCE: The recommendations in respect of these allowances, made by Justice Padmanabhan Committee, have been accepted.

(v) ENCASHMENT OF LEAVE: Grant of encashment of leave as admissible under CCS (Leave) Rules will be continued.

The recommendation on the facility of additional Home Travel Concession (HTC) to judicial officers of UTs has not been accepted.

RETIREMENT BENEFITS:

The recommendations of the Justice Padmanabhan Committee in respect of pension, gratuity, family pension and medical allowance to judicial officers who retired on or after 1.1.2006 have been accepted. Additional pension/additional family pension for pensioners/family pensioners on attaining a specified age on par with Government pensioners may be granted as per the pattern of 6th Central Pay Commission report. Commutation of pension for judicial officers upto a maximum of 40% of the pension will be continued.

The recommendations of Justice Padmanabhan Committee with regard to revised pension and medical allowance to past pensioners/family pensioners i.e. who retired prior to 1.1.2006 have been accepted.

A cash payment of Rs.2500/- per month as domestic help allowance to every retired judicial officer has been accepted with the proviso that a certificate has to be produced to this effect. No such allowance shall be given to family pensioners of judicial officers.

2. The above mentioned allowances (except DA) of serving/retired judicial officers of the Union Territories may be revised with effect from 1st September, 2008.
3. The expenditure involved shall be met out of Budget provisions of the concerned Union Territories.
4. This issues with the concurrence of D/o Expenditure, M/o Finance vide IC U.O. Note No.10/1/2010-IC dated 23.2.2010 & U.O. No.7.24/4/2009-IC dated 26.07.2011.
